

DOOR DÉCOR; WOVEN FISH

Using the patterns, cut several fish; three is a good number. Then, using the dotted lines as a guide, cut slits on the fishes' bodies. Be careful not to cut too close to the edge.

Use a variety of bright colors when constructing this décor project. The bodies may be dark green or dark blue then use red, yellow, orange, lavender, or a lighter shade of blue or green for the "scales".

Using the many colors, cut $\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips from the construction paper. You can make them as long as the paper and then cut to fit after the weaving is complete. Simply weave different colored strips in and out of the slits, forming brightly colored scales. Use scotch tape on the back side to hold the woven pieces in place.

Tape the fish to the door. Then cut several sizes of bubbles and arrange them as if drifting up through the water.
