

## DECEMBER DOOR DÉCOR

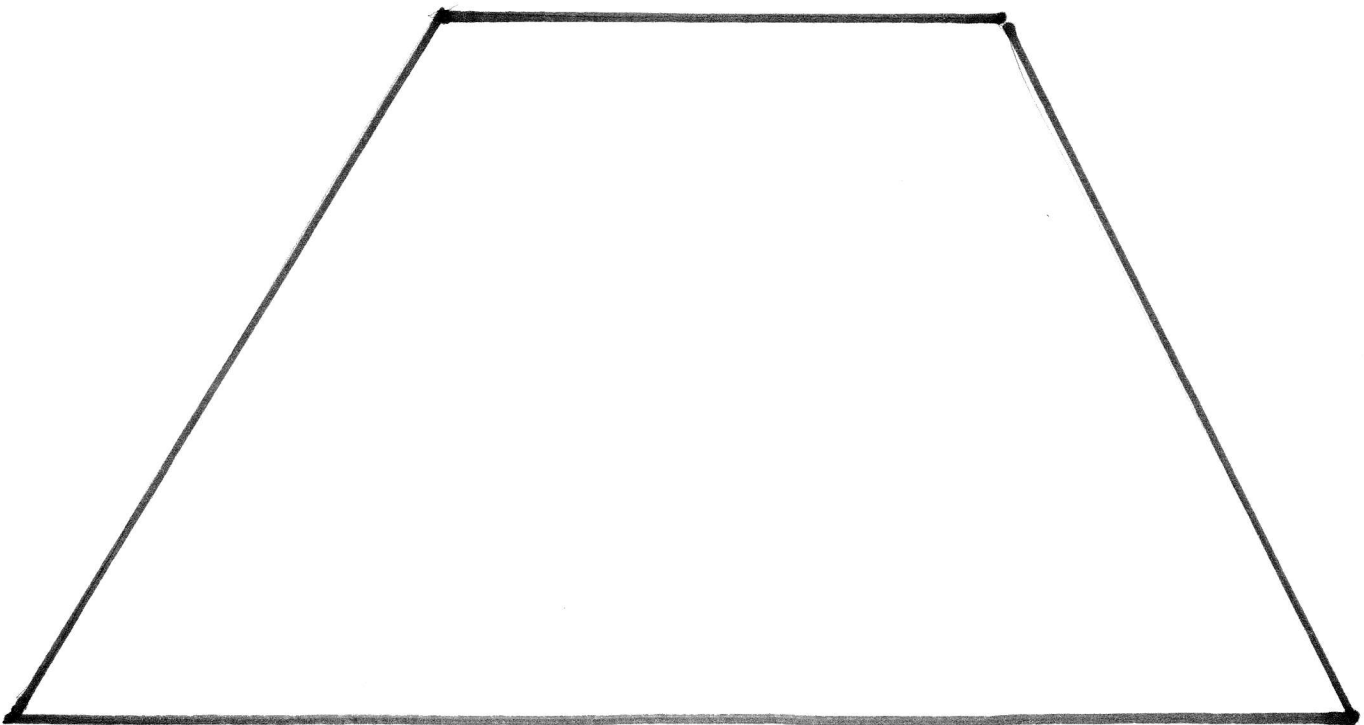
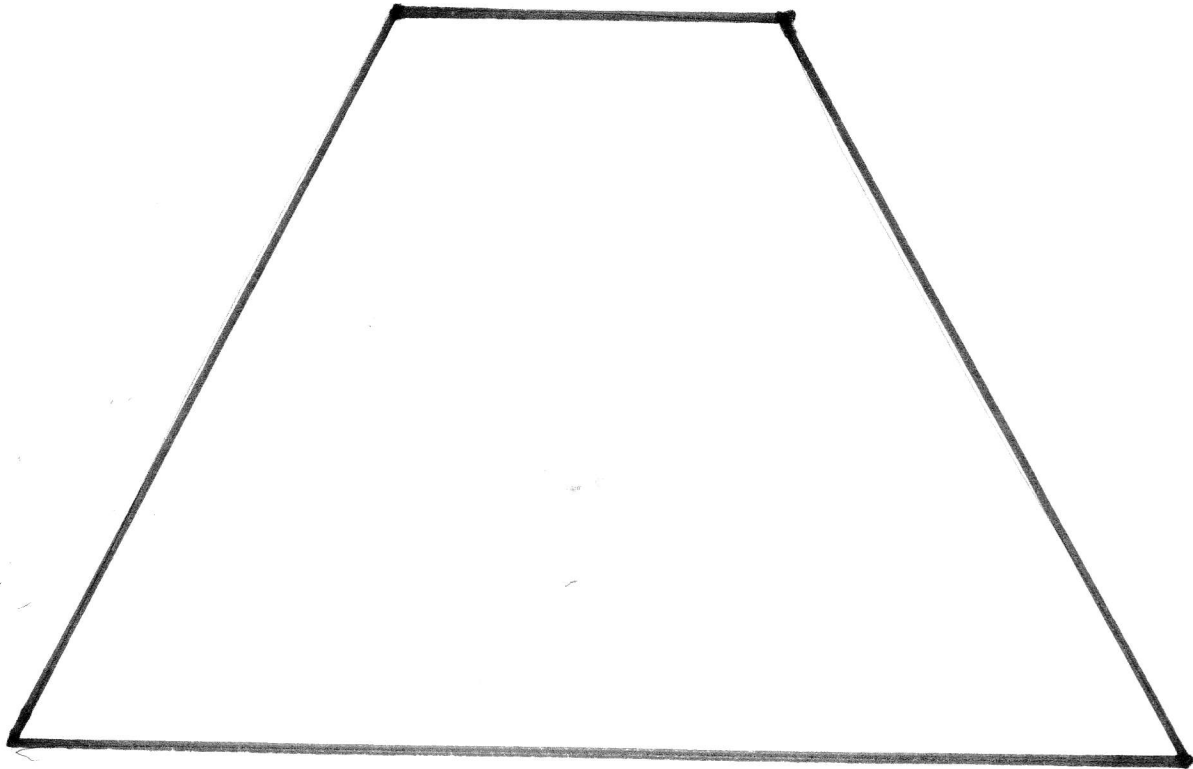
This is a simple pattern but it can be used to construct multiple trees of varying heights and leaning persuasion.

Utilizing two or three different shades of green construction paper, stack three sheets together. Using the pattern, cut through all three at the same time, thereby giving you multiple pieces with each cut.

Once you have all your pieces, assemble them into the height you want. Using a variety of heights with different colors of green on each tree will add eye appeal.

Once the trees are assembled, decorate in any way you like. Using the pattern for old fashioned light bulbs, you can add an array of bright colors. Buttons also work well as would Elmer's Glue and glitter for round shiny balls. Placing the silver glitter on the tips of the tree branches depicts the snow fall. More trees add more appeal. Saving the decorations for just one tree in the "forest" makes the idea of a Christmas tree special and eye catching.
