
These patterns will let you make an array of flowers in a very short time. Choose three or four bright colors of construction paper, stack three of them together. Using one of the patterns cut through all three pieces, giving you a great start on a flower garden. Choose different colors, stack them again, and use the second pattern to cut three more flowers. You can cut the centers in the same way, by stacking black, purple, and dark brown construction paper and cutting three at a time.

The bumble bees are made in the same way except you will use only yellow paper for the bee bodies and white for the wings. To add visual features to the bees, a little white glue and glitter gives structure to the wings and wiggle eyes are cute.

Use your creativity for decorating the flowers.

Lay your flowers and bees out on a table and arrange them until you have the best design. Then use the white glue to stick them all together. They are ready to hang on the door using a few short strips of folded masking tape. (remember to place the tape vertically, so the "roll" cannot roll down the door!)
