

LUCKY DOG

This game can be played by any number of players of various skill levels. The object of the game is simply to be the first to get rid of all your cards.

Start by making copies of the number page provided. You will need one page per player. Cover the pages with clear contact paper before cutting them out. (Contact paper will make them heavier and easier to handle, they will last longer and they will be easy to clean. Laminating is OK but the cards will be thin and harder to pick up and they will glare making them difficult to see.)

Gather players and give each a set of six cards. Participants lay the cards in front of them, face up. Provide dice, players will roll only one.

Play begins when one player chooses a card and sets it away from the others. That player then rolls the dice. If the number rolled matches the card set aside, the card is turned over and the same player gets to choose another card. They roll again. Play continues until an inappropriate number is rolled. The card is returned to the front of the player and the dice moves to the next participant. The first player to turn over all cards is the winner.
