Socks Matching Activity

PURPOSE:

- Practice gross & fine motor skills
- o Promote use of everyday familiar objects
- Practice visual discrimination

MATERIALS:

- Storage container for loose socks
- Box to contain matched socks
- Several pairs of socks of various colors
- Clothes pins (spring type)
- Container for pins

SETUP:

- 1. Place the container of loose socks on the table
- 2. Place the empty box next to the full one
- 3. Place container of clothes pins within easy reach
- 4. It may be necessary to empty the loose socks onto the table to make them more accessible

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Pick up one sock
- 2. Search through the pile of loose socks for a mate
- 3. Place the mates together
- 4. Secure socks with a clothes pin
- 5. Place matched set in the box provided
- 6. Continue until all the socks have been matched, pinned, and boxed

DOWNWARD EXTENSION:

Remove clothes pins from already matched socks; place the socks in the box and the pins into their container

UPWARD EXTENSION:

Match the socks and roll them up, turning the bottom sock over the roll. Then place the rolled socks into the box

PROBLEMS & SOLUTIONS:

P: Resident is unable to match colors

S: Provide only the most vibrant colors; remove those that are close in color

P: Resident is unable to manipulate the clothes pin or roll the socks

S: Ask the resident to simply find mates and lay them in the box

P: Resident is unable to roll and turn the socks

S: Provide larger pairs of socks (small socks are more difficult to manipulate)
