

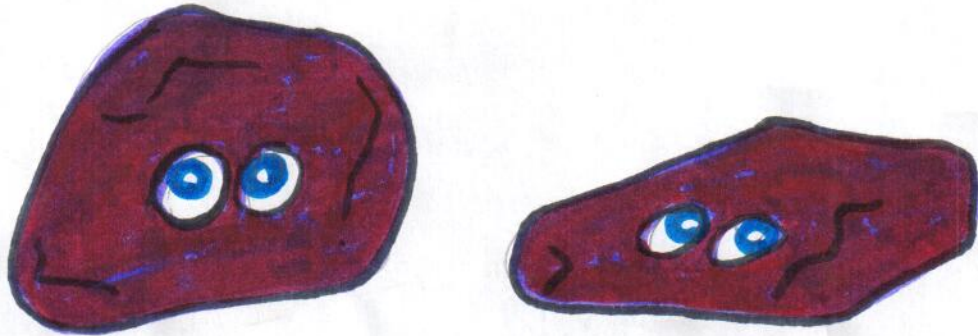
CLAM SEARCH; a staff-only activity

This activity requires the construction of about 20 clams. These clams are simply small rocks, painted a dark glossy purple and given some cute eyes. Make copies of the directions and post a copy in each work area.

The facilitator of this activity must be familiar with the facility, being able to get into all staff areas, and be willing to spend a little time hiding the clams. It helps to keep track of where the clams are hidden but not a necessity. It's more important to do the hiding while staff are occupied elsewhere. One can simply walk around with a few clams in a pocket and when the opportunity arises, simply stick one into a good hiding place. (in the supply closet, between bottles of hand sanitizer, in the linen closet, peeking from behind the wash cloths, in the copy room, partially hidden by the copier or the paper cutter, in the kitchen pantry between boxes of cereal, etc.)

When a clam is turned in, make note of where it was found. When most, or all, of the clams have been found, hide them all again. It takes at least one round for the staff to catch on to what is required, even though the directions are posted !
