THE WHITE ELEPHANT/ CHRISTMAS QUIZ GAME

This is an activity for individuals who can answer questions concerning Christmas carols and participate in a gift exchange game. It is most fun when there are at least six participants; the more the merrier! A large round table works best. Staff donate the white elephant gifts. You will need to have one gift for each participant so plan on having more than anticipated so no one will be left out. Any left over gifts can be used for the next game. A list of possible gift ideas will follow. The gifts are wrapped and set aside. Copy the Christmas carol quiz game sheet and the page of numbered cards. Laminate them both so they can be cleaned and reused. Cut the numbered cards into individual pieces. Begin the activity with the quiz. Use your judgement as to format; do you take turns providing each participant the opportunity to answer or do you simply toss out the question to the group. This will depend on the make-up of your individuals. Once the quiz has been completed, inform the participants that it is time for the white elephant game! Place all the wrapped gifts in the middle of the table. Lay the numbered cards, face down, on the table and mix them around. Ask each participant to draw a card and keep their number a secret... this just adds a bit to the fun. Once everyone has a card, explain that the person holding #1 may choose any gift from the collection. They must then open the gift and show everyone what they have. Next, #2 chooses a gift, unwraps it and shows everyone. The #2 player can then trade with #1 if they so desire. (Trading gifts is the fun of the

game!). Next, #3 chooses, opens the gift, and may then trade with #1 or #2. The game continues until all gifts have been chosen. Then, the #1 player gets to trade with any of the other participants. Some may feel bad about taking someone elses gift but do encourage trading as a part of the game. To encouorage the trading activity, a staff member may keep card #2 and participate. Trading their gift with the #1 player, thereby sets the example. When all is said and done, participants may take their gifts home or donate them back for the next game.
